



SMOKING AND IGNITION SOURCE POLICY

Silver City Drilling is committed to ensuring that personnel, contractors and visitors are not exposed to ignition and explosion risks at worksites, and tobacco smoke in workplaces including buildings and vehicles.

Smoking is prohibited:

- At all Silver City Drilling sites unless at an area designated as a smoking area;
- At fuel storage areas or whilst refuelling vehicles;
- Whilst working near batteries, or servicing any equipment where any flammable substance is present;
- At gas storage areas;
- Within all Silver City Drilling buildings, accommodation units and vehicles; and
- At other areas designated as no smoking areas by signage.

Ignition sources including lighters and matches are prohibited within 15 metres of a drill collar, well head or other known sources of gas, unless under the control of an authorised permit.

The Company seeks to ensure the comfort, safety and rights of all persons and, as far as is practicable, non-smokers shall not be subjected to smoke inhalation.

The Smoking and Ignition Source Policy enables Silver City Drilling to safeguard the safety and health of its personnel, contractors and visitors in accordance with Legislative requirements, and reduces the risk of fire and explosion.

All persons working at or visiting Silver City Drilling sites are required to comply with this policy.
